I. SCOPE OF POLICY

Academic Eligibility policy focuses on the rules and regulation set by the AIU and The Ministry of Higher Education regarding the eligible students to apply to AIU as a first-time admission to Higher Education Institute.

The policy presents the requirements from each type of high school graduates; ex: Thanawya Amma, Azhar, STEM, National, American, British, Abitur, Arab countries certificates. For which are subject to be updated each semester.

The policy also presents the procedures to apply through the central application form for National Universities, take the entrance exams and complete the admission to be an enrolled student.

II. **DEFINITIONS**

Prospective Students: individuals from the community which to apply to AIU to become a student. Applicant: prospective student who applies through the application form.

Student: accepted applicant who received acceptance letter in one of AIU programs and submitted all documents, paid the tuition and fees, signed all admission forms, and finally accepted by the MoHE.

- Students must have achieved an overall score equivalent to Egyptian Thanweya Amma.
- College dashboard username and password for SAT and/or ACT subjects.
- Students must pass the Arabic exam of Thanweya Amma before or after the final acceptance in the university.
- Students must submit proof of 12 years of schooling.
- Students must pass all the required admission tests and other requirements if any.

Attestation:

- 1- Grade 10, 11 and 12 from:
 - a. The issuing institute.
 - b. General Examination Administration
 - c. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Egyptian Embassy at the issuing country
- 2- SAT, ACT, and EST
 - a. Amideast (for SAT only)
 - b. General Examination Administration (ACT and EST only)
 - c. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Egyptian Embassy at the issuing country (for SAT only)
- 3- Proof of 12 years of schooling attested from the education department
- 4- Private education attestation (a list of all school graduates)
- 5- Proof of passing the Arabic Exam attested from the education department

Other Requirements:

- Students must have achieved an overall score equivalent to Egyptian Thanweya Amma.
- The final grade is calculated from the past four years only for five trials most.
- Students must pass the Arabic and religion exams of Thanweya Amma before or after the final acceptance in the university.
- Students must submit proof of 12 years of schooling.
- Students must pass all the required admission tests and other requirements if any.



Attestation:

- 1- Original IG grades from
 - a. the British Council
 - b. Ministry of Foreign Affairs or the Egyptian Embassy at the issuing country
 - c. General Examination Administration (inside Egypt)
- 2- Proof of 12 years of schooling attested from the education department
- 3- Proof of passing the Arabic and Religion Exam attested from the education department. (if the student took Arabic as first language in the OL, he will be exempt from submitting the Arabic exam)



Entrance Exams

The student who applies for AIU must take the entrance exam. exams take three hours and are held in one of the universities in Egypt or online for students whom live abroad. In the following topics:

- 1- English Exam
- 2- Critical thinking
- 3- Subject exam in the field that the student applied for. There are several fields where student may take exams in up to three of them; Medical, Science, Mathematics, Humanities and Art.

Entrance Exams Fees:

Students are allowed to take the entrance exams in up to three fields. Student will pay 750 L.E for one field, another 500 L.E for the second field, and another 500 L.E for the third and last field.

Required Documents during the application phase:

- 1- Copy of the high school certificate
- 2- Copy of the birth certificate.
- 3- Copy of the national ID/ or Passport for non-Egyptian applicants
- 4- A prove of residence in the country of the graduating certificate.
- 5- Copy of the receipt of the admission and Entrance Exams fees.

Required Documents during the admission phase:

- 1- Original high school certificate.
 - a. A prove of spending 12 years of schooling for non-Egyptian certificates.
 - b. Certificates obtained outside Egypt must be attested by the Egyptian embassy at the country the certificate was obtained at and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country issuing the certificate.
- 2- Original birth certificate.
- 3- 2 copies of the national ID for Egyptian students. Or 1 copy of the passport for non-Egyptian students.
- 4- 6 new passport sized photos.
- 5- A prove of residence in the country of the graduating certificate for both the student and the guardian parent.
- 6- Military application for Male Egyptian students.
- 7- Receipt of Medical Check-up for 1000 L.E.
- 8- Receipt of the semester tuition fees.
- 9- Receipt of the annual Administrative Fees for 4250 L.E.
- 10- Receipt of Military training for male students only for 750 L.E.

IV. **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Students are responsible for applying through the application form and follow-up the application feedback and their email for any communication.
- Admission department personnel, are responsible for communicating with prospective students guiding them through the application process and offering information till they are admitted to the university.
- Ministry of Higher Education (MoHE), is responsible for setting the eligibility requirement each semester, controlling the application form, holding the entrance exams and announce the accepted applicants list.
- Supreme Council of Universities, Audit the eligibility of each student to be enrolled in the correspondence program and officially enroll them in the MoHE records.

V. POLICY STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES

- 1- Applying through the official link through the following link: <u>https://admission.egypt-hub.edu.eg/</u>.
- 2- First screening Checking the minimum requirements
- 3- Entrance Exams
- 4- Announcing the result of the admission after calculating the admission percentage which is a combination of (70% of high school grade + 30% of the entrance exams grade)
- 5- Sending acceptance email to accepted applicants though they are requested to submit the original and official documents at AIU admission office.
- 6- Students must attend the orientation week which is held at AIU campus.
- 7- Ministry of Higher Education enrolls accepted students in its records.
